Medtronic announces first procedures in Europe with Stealth AXiS™ Surgical System

More than 23 procedures performed across seven sites in Germany, the United Kingdom, Italy, and Spain

GALWAY, Ireland - September 10, 2026 - Medtronic, a global leader in healthcare technology, announced the first clinical procedures using the Stealth AXiS™ surgical system across Europe, marking an important milestone as surgeons begin clinical use of the system across the region.

The initial procedures include spine procedures, providing early clinical experience with a platform that integrates AI-driven surgical planning, real-time navigation and robotic-assisted execution.

"This technology represents a significant step forward in the way we undertake some of the most complex spinal procedures. Revision surgery of this nature can be exceptionally challenging due to the presence of existing implants and altered anatomy. The precision offered by Stealth AXiS™ system enables us to plan meticulously and execute that plan with greater confidence, accuracy and efficiency. Ultimately, the greatest benefit is for our patients, helping us deliver the safest possible surgery while pushing the boundaries of what can be achieved in complex spinal care," said Mr. Sean Molloy, Consultant Spinal Surgeon at Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital (RNOH), United Kingdom.

The Stealth AXiS™ system is part of Medtronic's AiBLE™ smart ecosystem, which connects technologies and information across the surgical journey, from planning through the procedure and beyond. The system is designed to support an integrated approach to surgical care across spine and cranial procedures.
